MAGNIFICENT SEVEN'S PIT STOP REGULATIONS

All competitors will enter the pits for a mandatory one minute pit stop. The minute will start when the car is stationary. After one minute the car can leave this position. The pit lane speed limit must be observed at all times.

Single drivers must remain seated with the seat belts correctly fastened, the engine may remain running. The competitor or team members are responsible for timing the minute pit stop and race winner's penalties, where penalties are appropriate.

Two-car teams pit stop time starts when the incoming car is stationary next to the second car without obstructing other competitors. At the end of one minute the second car may leave it's position. The second car's engine may be started when the timed pit stop starts. The drivers or team members are responsible for timing the minute stop and race winner's penalty if appropriate.

For two drivers sharing one car, the one minute pit stop starts when the incoming car is stationary. The driver change may start when the engine has been turned off. When the second driver is seated in the car with the seat belts fitted correctly, the engine may be re-started. After one minute the car may leave it's position. The drivers or team members are responsible for timing the minute stop and race winner's penalty if appropriate .

Any infringement of the mandatory one minute pit stop or excessive speed in the pit lane will be penalised.

OUTRIGHT RACE WINNERS PENALTIES

A penalty of thirty seconds will be awarded to the outright race winners only. The penalty will remain in place until the end of the season. If the same competitor wins further races, an additional thirty seconds will be added to the original thirty seconds for each race win. This penalty will be added to the mandatory one minute pit stop.

Class winners do not receive any winner's penalties.
