Croft Circuit – 22nd/23rd July 2017

Supplementary Regulations



1. **The Classic Sports Car Club** will organise and promote a Race Meeting at Croft, North Yorkshire on Saturday 22nd July and Sunday 23rd July 2017.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations and any written Instructions the organising Club may issue for the event.
3. MSA permit numbers 99267 (Clubmans), 99268 (National B).
This event is not NCAFP inscribed.
4. The meeting is open to all fully elected members of the organising Club and members of the Jaguar Enthusiasts Club. SEE D,4.3.1
5. Rounds of the following Championships will take place:
Toyo Tires/Watchdogapp.com Jaguar Saloon and GT Championship (Championship Permit No. CH2017/R110)
6. Competitors must hold MSA racing licences of National B or higher grade and (if applicable) Club membership cards. All these documents will be inspected at signing-on. Please note that competitors holding a licence not issued by the MSA can only participate with written authorisation from their ASN (article 18 FIA International Sporting Code).
Drivers requiring signatures on their Upgrade Card should leave them with the organisers when signing-on.
7. The Circuit is Croft and is 2.1 miles (3.380km) in length. Racing will be in a clockwise direction.
8. Scrutineering will start at 07.30 on Saturday and 10.00 on Sunday, in the Scrutineering Bay. Qualifying starts at 09.00 on Saturday and at 12.00 on Sunday. The meeting will open at 07.30 on Saturday and 10.00 on Sunday. Any competitor not signed-on by 11.00 on Saturday or 14.00 on Sunday may be excluded.
9. The Races, Classes and Awards,

If the same car and driver is registered for a second series and entered for a second race at this meeting, the entry fee for the second series race is reduced by £25. The 40 minute CSCC Meteor Suspension Open series race is already discounted to £225 for all cars and drivers already entered in the meeting, for others it is £385. The 15 minute CSCC Meteor Suspension Open series race is already discounted to £99 for all cars and drivers already entered in the meeting, for others it is £149. Class Structure and Awards as per Series Regulations.

10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and **closes on Wednesday 19th July 2017**. To encourage early entry all entries received after Sunday 9th July will incur an additional £30 fee. This also applies to second drivers in CSCC Series. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER WEDNESDAY 19th July 2017**. CSCC and JEC members already entered into the meeting may enter the CSCC Meteor Suspension Open Series race up until one hour before the start of qualifying for that race. **Registered CSCC and JEC drivers may enter and pay online using the ProSolve booking system** up until Sunday 9th July but all other entries must be made on the official form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. *To save administration time and costs, entries will be acknowledged by e-mail whenever possible. Please include your e-mail address on the entry form.* E-mailed entry forms (complete with signature) must not contain credit/debit card details, instead please call the office with these after e-mailing the form. Entry information may also be faxed or posted. Entry will only be accepted on receipt of the fee and properly completed form. Cheques should be made payable to Classic Sports Car Club Ltd. Entries will be selected to conform with H.30 and i) Registered Championship/Series contenders first and ii) entry forms received in chronological order. Entry fees will be refunded under the terms of H.31.1.2 if a competitor notifies the organiser **in writing, email or by FAX** by 5.00pm on Wednesday 19th July 2017. An administration fee of £25.00 will be deducted. **There will be NO REFUNDS after this date.**
All credit card entries will incur a £3 surcharge.

11. The maximum number of starters in each race will be 40 and the minimum will be 20. The minimum number of entries in each class will be 3. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right either to cancel the meeting or the race or amalgamate qualifying, races or classes, or substitute races as appropriate.

13. Competition Numbers must be displayed in accordance with J.4.1/Q11.4. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that numbers are properly presented for scrutineering as per Q.11.1.1 and are clearly visible for practice and race.
14. Grid positions are determined by times recorded in official qualifying, except in the CSCC Special Saloons & Modsports and the Toyo Tires/Watchdogapp.com Jaguar Saloon and GT Championship where the grid for the second race will be determined by the finishing positions of the first race. The grid for the CSCC Special Saloons & Modsports third race will be determined by the finishing positions of the second race. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written.
15. **Rolling starts will be used for all races.**
The starting signal for all races will be given by lights. In the event of any starting lights failure the Starter will revert to use of the Union Flag.
16. Provisional results will be announced as soon as possible after each race in Race Administration.
17. Protests. Entrants are reminded that protests should be made in accordance with MSA General Regulations C.5.1.
18. Fuel supplies are not available at the circuit.
19. Admission per single driver entry will be 4 Personnel passes. If part of a two driver team the second driver will receive an additional two personnel passes. No animals are allowed.
20. In qualifying it is a competitor's responsibility to ensure that he/she completes the requisite number of laps. Some qualifying sessions may be amalgamated.
21. Parc Ferme will take place in the area at the end of the garages or as directed by officials.
22. Judges Of Fact (G.10.2) will be named for: Judges, Technical, Timing, Flag infringements and Track Limits.
23. **Race engines must not be run before 08.30 or after 18.30 on Saturday and not before 11.30 or after 18.30 on Sunday.**
Competitors not complying with this may be reported to the Clerk of the Course.
24. Transponders will be required at this meeting as per Q.12.2.1. Please make sure your number is CLEARLY written on your entry form.
25. In the case of the abandonment or cancellation of the Meeting, the organisers will retain sufficient of the entry fees in order that costs/expenses incurred shall be covered.
