

Entries for the **Spa 3 Hours race** (pre-77 FIA cars) at the Spa Summer Classic at Spa Francorchamps are now open. Drivers don't need to be a CSCC member or have registered a car to enter this race, through the CSCC. Those of you who have already registered for the Midland Classic Restorations Ecurie Classic K or Mike Hawthorn Jaguar Challenge and have had your confirmation email back from us may now enter online, through our race booking system: <https://cscrm.prosolvehosting.co.uk:485/login.aspx>

The price for the 3 Hours is £2050, for 2 or 3 drivers.

You do not need an International Race Licence in order to take part. A Motorsport UK Race National is the minimum required.

If you are wanting to race at Spa in our other CSCC races, please be patient, we will open entries to these races in February.

Regulations

The regulations for the 3 Hours are published on the webpage linked to above. The updated 2026 RACB safety regulations will be available soon, but we don't anticipate any radical differences from those issued in 2025. Key differences from the UK are a need for an in-date FIA seat (or period original), FIA roll cage padding where your head might contact a bar, FIA holograms on all clothing except socks (which must still have FIA labels) and full FIA underwear. Please be aware that an FHR (HANS/Simpson) is mandatory for all cars from Jan 1st 1962 (Period F onwards).

Sign on and scrutineering will take place on Thursday 23rd and Friday 24th April.

There will be NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS for any withdrawals received after this, with the exception of those who are on a reserve list. We may offer a refund if there is a reserve to fill your place.
