Tickets will be emailed to Officials shortly, please check your junk folder. Marshals can gain access to the Circuit using your **Motorsport UK card/ PRC**.

Standing starts will be used for all races except: Liqui Moly Slicks

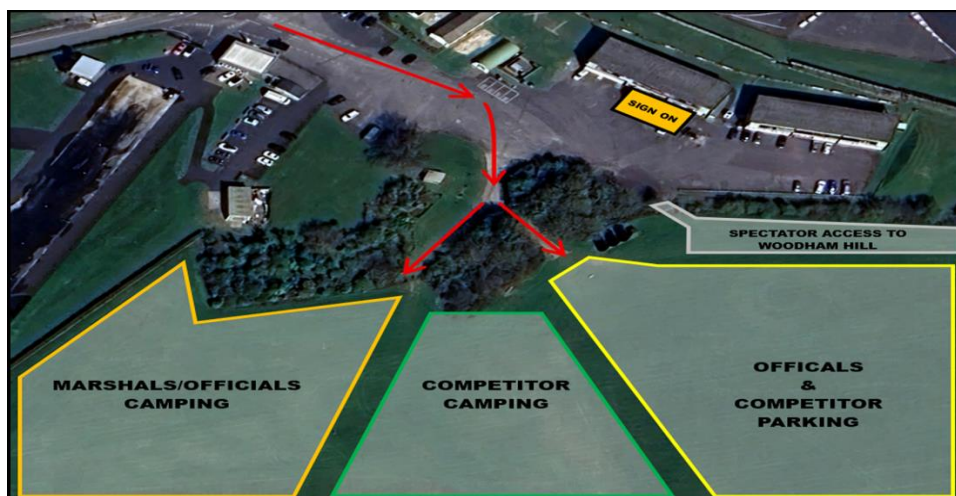
Check in from 07.30 in the Marshal Hut (Old BARC Shop)

Any Marshals coming in their vehicle to 'Check In', please park in the marshals' campsite/carpark area and walk over to the marshals' portacabin. Here you will be greeted, ticked off a list, given £10 courtesy of the CSCC and their drivers, as a gesture of thanks, and where appropriate, issued a radio and Code 60 flag. Please return your radio to Marshals sign-on, at the end of the day and Code 60 flag at the end of the meeting.

After checking in, you will be allowed to drive to your various posts if required. Please obey the circuit speed limit (20 mph) and directions by the circuit staff.

The post-chiefs briefing will take place outside of the Thruxton Centre.

All Marshals/Officials Car Parking & Camping will be in the marshals' campsite/carpark area. To reach this area, come up the main drive, turn right at the roundabout and the entrance is opposite the rear of the 1st grandstand (see map in section 5 below). This is a grass area, there is no electric hookup. There will be a toilet & shower block in the campsite. Alternative water and toilets are underneath the grandstand, and alternative showers are in the paddock area opposite the scrutineering bay.

Food - The Thruxton Centre is open for takeaway food and drink. Unless you are working within the paddock area, please can you park in the outside car park, or on the start line, rather than attempting to go through the tunnel into a very busy paddock. Having eaten, you may then move to your post.

On track incident - If driver's breakdown, or have an accident on track, they have been briefed to show you the thumbs up signal, to indicate they are in good health and can exit the car to a place of safety without your assistance. Please return the thumb to confirm you have seen theirs. It has been requested that you then indicate to your Post Chief either an outstretched, horizontal arm with thumb up, to show 'all ok', or a vertical arm up to indicate 'I need assistance'. This is in addition to a radio call to report the incident.

Driving Standards - The CSCC expect high driving standards, no 'rubbing is racing', so please report everything you see and it will be acted upon, if not by the Clerks, then the club will look at it after the meeting. Your reports are very much appreciated.

Code 60 - Code 60 is in operation in all sessions, as is the Safety car. We will not use live snatch.

Race Control, Assembly Area and Pit Lane

With the exception of the Co-ordSport Tin Tops and Puma Cup team members are required to wear a race specific, coloured wrist band in order to access the pit wall. Wrist bands are not required for those working in the pit lane, within Motorsport UK maximum numbers. The wrist band colours can be seen on the timetable. Race and club officials will be wearing a blue 'access all areas' band to allow them into those areas.

Co-ordSport Tin Tops and Puma Cup will not be issued wristbands, as a trial, instead, they will be strongly encouraged to wear a green or orange (only) high-vis jacket or tabard. Please can the pit lane team monitor the suitability of those on the pit wall in all sessions.

We look forward to welcoming you there and hope you enjoy the race weekend.
