As a gesture of thanks from CSCC, each Marshal will be given £10. Silverstone will also be providing a lunch bag and a drink. This will be delivered to post by the IO when they take their post's box in the morning.

If you arrive after check-in has finished, please report to Race Administration, where you can check-in and be allocated a duty and post for the day.

The campsite will be open from 12pm Friday – 12pm Monday. The Marshal's campsite is located at Winterhills, behind the UTC building. To access, go through the main gate and turn left. Follow the road round until you reach Silverstone UTC (big grey and red building). Once you have passed the UTC turn left into Gate 5, this will bring you out into the campsite.

Please be aware there is a strict 20mph speed limit on all Silverstone's internal roads

Due to the event being extremely busy, space will be very limited so please do not park your cars in the paddock area.

Please remember to bring plenty of food and drink, with clothing for every eventuality.
