Briefings

If you have never raced at the Oulton Park International circuit, you must attend a new-to-circuit briefing before you drive on track (see timetable). All other drivers must attend their category briefing as shown in the timetable. Briefings are held on the top floor of the race control building.

Have you signed on and previously sent us a copy of your 2026 Race Licence once this year?

Timetable:

We will always aim to run up to 30 minutes ahead, carrying any time we gain in the morning through to the afternoon.

Code 60 and Safety Car:

Motorsport UK is currently not permitting the use of Code 60 in qualifying sessions, but we have received a permit to use the safety car in both qualifying and race sessions at Oulton.

Track Limits:

These are as per Motorsport UK NCR regulations, but be particularly aware of running wide on the exits of Old Hall, Cascades and Druids.
