

# Mallory Mix Race Meeting

## Supplementary Regulations (Issued 27/02/26)



1. **The Classic Sports Car Club** will organise and promote a Race Meeting at Mallory Park Circuit on **Saturday 18th April 2026**.
2. The meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules 2026 of Motorsport UK (Edition 2) (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the organising Club may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK permit number: 206510 (Interclub).  
The following Championship races will also take place:  
Lackford Engineering Midget & Sprite Challenge: Permit TBC
4. The meeting is open to all fully elected members of the organising Club.
5. Competitors must hold a Motorsport UK race licence of Race Club or higher grade. (Please note NCR Ch. 12 App. 4 Art. 6.2) **If you have not already done so when registering, please email a copy of your 2026 race licence to [info@classicsportscarclub.co.uk](mailto:info@classicsportscarclub.co.uk)**  
Please note that competitors holding a race licence not issued by Motorsport UK, can only participate with written authorisation from their ASN (article 2.3.7 FIA International Sporting Code).
6. The Circuit is Mallory Park circuit and is 1.35 miles in length. Racing will be in a clockwise direction.
7. Sign on is by digital sign on. Any competitor not digitally signed-on by 17:30 on Wednesday 15th April 2026, may be excluded. Scrutineering will be done for selected categories only, as listed within the Timetable and Final Instructions. There is no pre-event self-scrutineering.  
Qualifying starts at 09.30. The meeting will open at 07.30.  
**Race engines must not be run before 09:15 and after 18:00. Competitors not complying with this may be reported to the Clerk of the Course.**
8. Races - There will be 10 races as follows **(NOT IN TIMETABLE ORDER)**:

If the **same car and driver** is registered for, and entered into any additional race/s at this meeting, the entry fee for the additional (cheaper) race/s is reduced by 50%. Please note that if entering more than one race online, the online booking system is unable to automatically apply the discount, so you will need to pay full price initially. The CSCC will then refund any additional race discount to you as soon as possible, but certainly within two weeks of you booking.

\*Adams & Page Swinging 60's, Co-ordSport Tin Tops and Fox Transport Turbo Tin Tops with Trackday Solutions Puma Cup will have a 40 minute race, with a 15 minute mandatory pit-stop, bringing the total race time to 55 minutes. This is necessary in order to satisfy noise regulations at the circuit. Adams & Page Swinging 60's will have a timed 15 minute pit-stop in a change to their usual 'quick-as-you-can' format. Winner's penalties will apply as normal and be served in addition to the minimum pit-stop time.

The pit-window will open after 20 minutes. At this time, the PIT WINDOW OPEN boards will displayed at the control line and repeated just afterwards. The pit window will close once all cars have passed the PIT WINDOW OPEN boards the first time. When the PIT WINDOW OPEN boards are displayed, cars must make their mandatory pit-stop immediately. Cars continue at race pace, with overtaking permitted for the remainder of that lap, until coming into the pit lane, just after the Esses. Cars slow to the required pit lane speed and start their 15 minute pit-stop at the point they cross the pit-in timing line, stopping as directed by Marshals, close to the car in front. The race remains live, so a driver may get out of the car/change drivers with the engine switched off, bonnet may be lifted and basic checks and adjustments performed. Any car not pitting after they have crossed the control line once the PIT WINDOW OPEN board is displayed, will be shown the PIT WINDOW CLOSED sign and black flagged. The penalty for missing the mandatory pit stop window will be detailed in the final instructions.

After each car has completed their 15 minute pit-stop, drivers will exit the pit-lane back onto the track and commence the remaining 20 minutes of the race.

Further details will be published in the Final Instructions. Penalties will be applied as per usual, for any unsafe release, speeding in the pits, or short stops.

9. Class Structure and Awards are as per Championship/Series Regulations.
10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and **closes on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2026**. To encourage early entry, all entries received after Sunday 5th April 2026 will incur an additional £30 fee. This also applies to second drivers.  
**NO ENTRIES WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER WEDNESDAY 15<sup>th</sup> April 2026.**  
Registered CSCC drivers may enter and pay online using the ProSolve booking system up until Thursday 9th April, all other entries

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must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. To save administration time and costs, entries will be acknowledged by e-mail whenever possible. (See section 11, Reserves)

For your security, e-mailed entry forms (complete with signature) must not contain credit/debit card details, instead please call the office with these after e-mailing the form.

Entry will only be accepted on receipt of the fee and properly completed form. Cheques/cash are no longer accepted.

Entries will be selected to conform with (NCR Ch. 6 App. 1 Art. 10) and 1) Registered Championship/Series contenders first and 2)

Entry forms received in chronological order.

11. Reserves. As per (NCR Ch. 6 App. 1 Art. 10.4) Note that entering and paying online does not mean you have a confirmed place, the online system is unable to notify you if you are a reserve or on a waiting (non-qualifying reserve) list. We will notify you within 7 days of entering if you are a reserve or on a waiting list. If you are on the waiting (non-qualifying reserve) list, you are not officially entered into the meeting and are unable to take part in the event, unless others who entered ahead of you withdraw before qualifying takes place.
12. Refunds. Entry fees will be refunded in full under the terms of (NCR Ch. 6 App. 1 Art. 11.1) if a competitor notifies the organiser in writing by email of their withdrawal by the end of the day on Sunday 5th April 2026. Any withdrawals received from Monday 6th April 2026 up until the end of the day on the closing date on Wednesday 15th April 2026, will be refunded less a £25 administration fee. There will be NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS for any withdrawals received after the closing date of Wednesday 15th April 2026, with the exception of those who are on a reserve or waiting (non-qualifying reserve) list. If you need to withdraw your entry from a race with a reserve list, we may offer you a partial or full refund, provided you immediately notify the Secretary of the Meeting that you are withdrawing and that there is a paying entry that is able to fill your place at that time.
13. The maximum number of starters will be 30 cars and the minimum will be 10. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or the race. They may amalgamate or split qualifying, races or classes, substitute races or move competitors as appropriate.

15. Competition Numbers must be displayed in accordance with (NCR Ch. 7 App. 10 / NCR Ch. 7 App. 13 Diagram 1 / NCR Ch. 12 App. 4 Art. 5). It is the driver's/entrant's responsibility to ensure that numbers are properly presented for scrutineering as per (NCR Ch. 12 App. 4 Art. 5.2) and are clearly visible for qualifying and race. Note that in sessions that are combined with another category, where numbers would be duplicated, cars must display the correct numbers as allocated in the digital race programme.
16. Grid positions are determined by times recorded in official qualifying, except in:  
Lackford Engineering Midget & Sprite Challenge and R-Werks Special Saloons & Modsports, where the grids will be set as per Series/Championship regulations.  
Fox Transport Turbo Tin Tops / Trackday Solutions Puma Cup will have a split, two part start as per NCR Ch. 12 App. 6 Art. 6.15.  
Turbo Tin Tops cars will start ahead of the Puma Cup cars in both races.
17. All other General Regulations of Motorsport UK apply as written.
18. Standing starts will be used for all races except R-Werks Special Saloons & Modsports who will have a Rolling start. The starting signal for all races will be given by lights. In the event of any starting lights failure, the Starter will revert to the use of the National Flag.
19. Provisional results will be announced as soon as possible after each session on the CSCC electronic noticeboard at:

20. Protests. Entrants are reminded that protests should be made in writing in accordance with Motorsport UK (NCR Ch. 2 App. 9).
21. Admission: A single driver team will receive 4 personnel passes. If part of a two-driver team, the first driver will receive 4 personnel passes and the second driver will receive 2 personnel passes. No paddock vehicle passes are needed. No animals allowed.
22. During qualifying, it is a competitor's responsibility to ensure that he/she completes the requisite number of laps. Some qualifying sessions may be amalgamated or split (NCR Ch. 12 App. 6 Art. 3).
23. Parc Ferme will take place as directed by officials.



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24. Judges Of Fact (NCR Ch. 12 App. 3 Art. 2) will be named in the final entry list (digital event programme) for: Eligibility (Chief Scrutineer), Noise (Environmental Scrutineer) and Timing (Chief Timekeeper). Other Judges may be appointed as required, and will be detailed in Final Instructions, Entry List (digital event programme) or Bulletins.
25. Transponders will be required at this meeting as per (NCR Ch. 12 App. 6 Art. 2.2). Please make sure your number is clearly written on your registration/entry form and let us know if it changes. Transponders must be located as per manufacturers' instructions.
26. In the case of the abandonment or cancellation of races or the meeting, the organisers will retain sufficient of the entry fees in order that costs/expenses incurred shall be covered.



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
