Guest Speaker - Jake Hill

This year's CSCC guest speaker is Jake Hill. Jake may be our youngest speaker to date, but he has a wealth of experience. Best known for his successes in British Touring Cars, he is still in the running for this year's championship, with one meeting to go at the time of writing. Wins in Karting, Ginetta Junior, Ginetta Supercup and Carrera Cup preceded his ongoing run of eight seasons in BTCC.

Jake has entertained Goodwood crowds, with fantastic control behind the wheel of Skyline GTR and Capri, demonstrated his versatility with GT's in Europe, but has not turned his back on club-level competition, with wins over four seasons of racing with the CSCC too.
